RULES AND REGULATIONS OF

GREATER NEWARK CONSERVANCY'S PLOT-IT-FRESH COMMUNITY GARDEN

The Plot-It-Fresh season runs March 15 – November 15, weather permitting. Hawthorne Ave. site will be accessible during set hours when a staff member is present and the site will be closed for Observed Holidays.

Greater Newark Conservancy Agrees To: Identify all plots alpha-numerically, provide a water source, maintain the pathways and refund rental fees if requested in writing prior to May 15 (excluding \$5 cancellation fee).

The Renter Understands:

- 1. Applicants must be 18 years of age or older.
- 2. Priority will be given to renewal renters who file their yearly application during pre-registration (prior to 01/11/20). Newark residents will have the next priority. Additional renters will be wait-listed on a first-come, first-served basis.
- 3. New applicants may rent one-4' x 8' plot or two-4' x 4' plots; returning gardeners may rent up to two 4' x 8' plots (or equivalent). **Second plots will be distributed after the waitlist has been cleared.**
- 4. Fee must be paid when registration application is approved.
- 5. No refunds on or after April 15 (a \$5.00 cancellation fee will be assessed for refunds prior to May 15).
- 6. Plots are assigned to one person only and are **not transferable**. The responsibility for payment of fees, cleanup and other duties at the site will be the responsibility of the individual whose name is assigned to the plot.

Renters Must:

- 1. Check in with Greater Newark conservancy staff and display Garden ID when they enter the farm. The renters Garden Picture ID is required to enter the farm. If someone is to watch your plot for a short period of time they will need your Garden ID to enter the farm.
- 2. Check email at least 3 days for announcements
- 3. Plant by Memorial Day, maintain their plot throughout the season, and remove all material from their plot by the end of the season, November 15 (Weather Permitting). We define maintain as: Harvesting regularly, keeping beds weeded, and making sure bed is free of debris.
- 4. Notify Greater Newark Conservancy in writing, in advance, if they must abandon their plot.
- 5. Maintain their garden within the plot and keep the pathways clear. Anything outside the bed is subject to removal.
- 6. Only use approved, certified organic fertilizers and/or pest control products in a way as to not affect other plots.
- 7. Place unwanted plant material (weeds, dead plants) into the provided designated area.
- 8. Return all fools to the shed
- 9. Supervise minors.

Renters will not:

- 1. Plant, store supplies, or pile weeds outside of their plot. The walkways will remain clear at all times.
- 2. **Bring glass in to the farm** and will pick up and dispose of all trash properly.
- 3. Shade other plots with plants, and trellis or support structures are limited to a height of 5'.
- 4. Spray paint or otherwise mark plots, tools, or other Conservancy property.
- 5. Smoke on, or within 25 feet of, the site entrance
- 6. Harvest from anyone else's plot without their permission.
- 7. Leave Plot it Fresh Area unless accompanied by Greater Newark Conservancy staff.
- 8. Have pets at the farm.

Additional Rules and Regulations: 1. The renter agrees to comply with all federal, state, and local laws and regulations. 2. GREATER NEWARK CONSERVANCY ASSUMES NO LIABILITY FOR ACCIDENTS OR INJURY TO PARTICIPANTS OR OTHERS EITHER ON OR ADJACENT TO GREATER NEWARK CONSERVANCY PROPERTY. NEITHER DOES GREATER NEWARK CONSERVANCY ASSUME RESPONSIBILITY FOR ACTS OF VANDALISM OR LOSS OF CROPS OR PROPERTY DUE TO THEFT.
If you are found out-of-compliance with, or in violation of, the above agreements, it may result in immediate termination of plot use and a one-year ban from Greater Newark Conservancy's Community Gardens.
